CLINICAL ACTIVITIES SUMMARY

My main clinical activity remains the interpretation of skin biopsy specimens, including both tissue sent directly to our laboratory and slides sent in consultation for a second opinion. This activity includes the interpretation of biopsies forwarded from community dermatologists, as well as the interpretation of slides forwarded in consultation from community dermatologists, pathologists, and dermatopathologists, both from throughout the United States and from abroad. Our laboratory also evaluates and interprets biopsies submitted directly from UCSF physicians, as well as specimens submitted for direct immunofluorescence analysis. In recent years, I have interpreted and issued reports for more than 20,000 specimens of all types, of which 30% or more were cases referred to our laboratory in consultation for second opinions. I also continued in my administrative role as the co-director of the UCSF Dermatopathology Service, which is the clinical enterprise through which this extramural material reaches UCSF. During the last decade, we have also become the premier location for molecular

dermatopathology in the western United States. Testing modalities include FISH, CGH, clonality assessment, and massively parallel sequencing.

TEACHING AND MENTORING

TEACHING SUMMARY

The students that I spend the greatest amount of time with are pathology and dermatology residents, dermatopathology fellows, and visiting scholars from abroad. Much of the teaching

occurs in my favorite setting, at the multiheaded microscope. I guide students of dermatopathology to recognize pertinent microscopic features, to categorize the pattern or the fundamental pathologic process at hand, to compose a differential diagnosis, and to hone in on the specific diagnosis. I believe every case has teaching merit and that a point can be brought home on every biopsy, even the relatively mundane ones. I utilize increasingly specific questions to control the discussion, while maintaining a congenial and lighthearted atmosphere that I believe is conducive to learning. I include a large number of citations in my pathology reports, and copies of these reference articles are usually provided to our rotators in dermatopathology, to instill concepts through supplemental reading. Once a principle has been introduced, I work to bring up related issues to broaden the student's understanding of the concept.

A second level of resident instruction is provided as a didactic lecturer. I give monthly lectures within our ongoing dermatopathology curriculum and also deliver other invited presentations. My resident lectures are carefully planned to incorporate important general concepts, in conjunction with a review of the specific entities that residents need to know for clinical practice and in preparation for board examinations.

Not unexpectedly, I have a special bond with our dermatopathology fellows. The training of future colleagues provides one of greatest rewards in teaching. As the fellows' skills develop, I work to provide room for their own style to emerge and to permit their own diagnostic concepts to develop (and hopefully flourish). The dermatopathology fellows assume graduated responsibility for the dictation of cases and the selection of ancillary stains and studies, under my supervision. As their role as a diagnostician expands, I keep the fellows focused on the additional role of the pathologist as a communicator to other physicians, and meticulously edit their dictated efforts. I also strive to be a solid role model as a professional and as a person, through my own hard work, continuing study, interactions with other physicians and staff, and involvement with the community and with family.

I completed a new level of instruction as the Editor-in-Chief of the Journal of Cutaneous Pathology. In this role, I exercised control over the content and composition of the Journal on a monthly basis. With an eye to education of a discipline, I incorporated monthly editorial commentary into the Journal.

My role in the instruction of medical students and students in other medical fields is episodic. My involvement began as a didactic lecturer, and I have been invited to serve as a small group mentor as well. I also enjoyed past interaction with future medical students on a non-instructional basis during my service to the UCSF Admissions Committee.
