USCAP Annual Meeting 2025

The UCSF Pathology Department participated with record numbers at the 2025 Annual Meeting of the US and Canadian Academy of Pathology (USCAP), with our faculty and trainees involved in 69 posters and 20 platforms. In addition, faculty members served in 13 other roles, such as a lecturer or moderator/panelist. For the abstracts, we are very proud to note that 21 trainees (residents, fellows, post-docs), 3 UCSF medical students, and 40 AP faculty were co-authors. Among these abstracts, trainees presented 7 of these 20 platforms, and one of our UCSF medical students also presented a platform. Of further note, 13 trainees were involved with more than 1 abstract, and several also presented both a poster and platform! Twenty-nine faculty members had > 1 abstract, 18 had >3, and 8 had 5 or more, a truly remarkable accomplishment overall. The entire listing of events involving our department members is included below, with our faculty and trainees as well as other UCSF coauthors listed in Bold print in the Master Schedule for USCAP 2025 included below.

The Department also hosted the alumni reception on Sunday Mar 23, 8:30-10:30 pm for all of department attendees and alumni at the meeting, and the room was packed for the entire event from start to finish! We thank Dr Debnath for again hosting the party on behalf of the Department and to Kelly McNeill, our office manager, for her efforts in organizing the event. We also thank our department analysts Lyubov (Lulu) Loza and Aubrey Salinda for their help with the Fellowship Fair, the scheduling for all the trainee practice sessions for their posters and platforms (>30 overall), and for putting together the USCAP Master Schedule (included below), all of which is a big job given our incredible amount of participation in the meeting.

USCAP Companion Society Awards

As you all are aware, USCAP as well as other pathology/companion societies sponsor awards and prizes for the best abstracts presented by trainees. This year, we had two awardees as follows:

Matthew Zunitch, MD, PhD, was the winner of the 2025 Subspecialty Pathology Award for the best abstract in this category by a trainee, chosen by the Association of Directors of Anatomic and Subspecialty Pathology Society (ADASP), and co-sponsored by USCAP. This highly prestigious award is posted on the USCAP website and announced each year at the USCAP Annual Business and Awards meeting on the Tues afternoon. This award is selected through competitive review of over 300 abstracts by the ADASP abstract review committee. The winning abstract was entitled: "Implementation and Impact of Digitally-Optimized Histology", by UCSF authors MJ Zunitch MD, PhD; N Khorsandi MD, MPH; V Walavalkar, MD; YY Chen, MD, PhD; SE Umetsu MD, PhD; C Espiritu, MBA, BS; S Evans BS; GZ Laszik, MD, PhD. This abstract was presented as both a poster in the Stowell-Orbinson competition as well as a platform. The key part of this abstract presentation was the workflow algorithm showing how the implementation of the change took place, while demonstrating the necessary laboratory management skills. As Matt stated after receiving the award to our program director, Dr Ron Balassanian: "This was a team effort, and everyone deserves credit for making it succeed."

Kara Tanaka, MD, was one of the recipients of the International Society of Urological Pathology (ISUP)'s trainee travel stipend award. There were 3 recipients of the International Society of Urological Pathology (ISUP)'s trainee travel stipend award.
